

HELPFUL HINTS FOR TEMPORARY OCCASION LICENSE APPLICANTS

The list of helpful hints set out below is not an all-inclusive list of instructions for completion of a Temporary Occasion License application for the City of Johnson City, Tennessee. Instead, the list provides reminders to help applicants turn in applications that are complete. Incomplete and inaccurate applications are considered void and of no effect. The list of reminders set forth addresses commonly encountered mistakes.

1. The application must be submitted no less than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the event to give City staff time for review and background checks.
2. The Temporary Occasion Beer License must be considered and approved by the City Commission.
3. The applicant must attend the City Commission meeting to answer any questions that the Commissioners may have at that time regarding the event.
4. The application must be fully completed and must include all secondary documents at the time of application. For a 501(c)(3) or (4) charitable corporation, the required secondary document is a letter from the IRS recognizing the corporation as a charitable organization. For an applicant that possesses an on or off premises beer license, please attach a copy of that license. **Applicants holding a beer license do not qualify for a Temporary Occasion License, if they hold an on-premises liquor-by-the-drink license issued by the State of Tennessee.**
5. Applicants must pay a \$75.00 application fee at the time of application for each special occasion listed on the application. Please make checks payable to the City of Johnson City, Tennessee.
6. Please be aware that the selling, pouring and consuming of beer may not occur until a Temporary Occasion Beer License has been approved and issued by the City to the applicant. The license will be available on the morning after approval by the City Commission.

TO SELL BEER**

Temporary occasion licenses are issued in the name of the licensed applicant or the bona fide charitable, non-profit organization and to a natural person or persons, who are jointly responsible for compliance with all laws, rules, and regulations applicable.

For an applicant that possesses an on or off premises beer license, please attach a copy of that license. Applicants holding a beer license **do not qualify for this temporary occasion license, if they hold an on-premises liquor-by-the-drink license issued by the State of Tennessee.**

The permit shall be issued for no longer than one (1) forty-eight (48) hour period per event. All beer sales are subject to the limitations on the hours of sale imposed by law.

The application fee for each special occasion license is Seventy-Five Dollars (\$75.00).
