

RE: COMMUNICATION TOWER PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

The following is a list of circumstances which require review and permit of communication tower antennas:

- 1.) All newly constructed towers
- 2.) The addition of any new antennas on an existing tower
- 3.) If existing antennas are changed out, and the new antenna's height is 10% greater or more than the original
- 4.) Any full current electrical work (A/C or D/C) – low voltage requires no permit
- 5.) Any change to the footprint of the "compound" / fenced area around the base of an existing (new structures within the compound are ok as long as they do not include electrical work found in #1 above).

If none of the above are included in the scope of work relating to a communication tower, that project shall be exempt from review and permit.
