ORDINANCE NO. 4755-20

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 8, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 209 BY AMENDING (5) REQUIRING A CERTIFICATE OF SUBSTANTIAL COMPLETION AND ADDING (6) REQUIRING REGULATORY DISTANCE FOR LOCATION OF ON-PREMISES BEER LICENSE TO THE CODE OF THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY, OR ANY OTHER ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES HERETOFORE PASSED.

WHEREAS, for the purpose of promoting the public health, safety, comfort, convenience and general welfare of the people of Johnson City, Tennessee, the Board of Commissioners is authorized to regulate the business of selling, storing, transporting, distributing, purchase or possession of alcoholic beverages within the corporate limits of the City of Johnson City except in accordance with the provisions of the Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57, Chapter 3, and rules and regulations promulgated thereunder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF JOHNSON CITY
as follows:

SECTION I. That Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 209(5) of the City of Johnson City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(5) The city shall issue no license until the premises for which the application is filed has received a certificate of substantial completion from the city.

SECTION II. That Title 8, Chapter 2, Section 209(6) of the City of Johnson City Code is hereby added to read as follows:

(6) In no event shall an on-premises license be issued for the sale of beer within one hundred feet (100') of any school, child daycare center, park, playground, church or other bona fide religious establishment. The said one hundred feet (100') shall be measured from the center of the front door of the licensed premises to the center of the nearest entrance/exit door of any school building, child day care center or church building in a straight line. For playgrounds and parks the one hundred foot (100') measurement shall be from the center of the front door of the licensed premises to the nearest point on the property line bounding the playground or park in a straight line

SECTION III. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION IV. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on third and final reading and publication as required by law, the public welfare requiring it.
